FIELD TRIPS / SPECIAL ACTIVITIES: We will go on weekly field trips which are included in the cost of camp. The trips are scheduled so there are the same number of trips each day of the week. Children will receive a tie-dyed “camp shirt” which must be worn on all field trips for group identification.

SWIMMING: Campers have their own “water park” set up on the climbing side playground with a water slide, bubble machine, splash pool, and sprinklers.

ARTS AND CRAFTS: The campers will be creating craft projects daily in the Art Room.

HOME THEATRE: We have a large screen theater room where campers can watch movies when it's raining or just too hot. Much of our time is spent outdoors.

FOOD: Please provide your child with a bag lunch daily. We do have refrigeration. Snacks will be provided and the camp will make lunch or snacks on random days once a week. Milk and juice will be available for snacks and lunch.

STAFF: Miss Brenda, Miss Debi J., Miss Cathy, and Miss Debbie Z. are the camp counselors this summer.

VACATION: Summer camp lasts 10 weeks and registration will only be received from those who commit to the **ENTIRE** summer. **One** vacation week may be taken. A 2-day notice is necessary for days to be considered vacation. Days may be made up or switched out only if there is availability within the **same** week.

PAYMENT: Tuition must be paid in advance for your child to attend. Payments are to be made no more frequently than every 2 weeks and paid on the first day of the week which your child attends. There is a payment box at the “welcome desk” inside the front door of Bloomfield Hall. Cash payments can be made in the main building office.

REGISTRATION: Registration is on a first-come/first-serve basis. **ALL** registration forms must be completed and turned in along with a **\$25.00 registration fee**. This registration fee will be waived if you recruit someone for camp that is new to our program (ie. talk with the parents of your child's friends and get them to sign up as well.) A deposit of the **last 2 weeks** of the summer are also to be paid at registration time (unless you currently have another child at LCPC), and may be included in the same check as the registration fee.

COOLCAMP INFORMATION AND REMINDERS

SUNSCREEN:

PLEASE APPLY SUNSCREEN **BEFORE**, OR WHEN ARRIVING AT CAMP IN THE MORNING. IT WILL BE RE-APPLIED BEFORE GOING OUTSIDE FOR AFTERNOON PLAY.

FOOD REMINDERS:

*PLEASE PACK A **BROWN BAG LUNCH** DAILY; (A LUNCH BOX IS ACCEPTABLE EXCEPT FOR FIELDTRIP DAYS)
*WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL, THEREFORE NO NUTS OR PEANUT BUTTER IN LUNCHES. SUN BUTTER IS FINE BUT PLEASE MARK THE LUNCH SO WE KNOW IT IS SAFE! NO "LUNCHABLES" THAT CONTAIN DESSERTS SUCH AS BUTTERFINGERS, REESE'S PEANUT BUTTER CUPS, M&M'S, ETC.

PLEASE BRING: (PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING)

- *A RE-USABLE WATER BOTTLE
- *SWIMSUIT, TOWEL, WATER SHOES
- *NON-COLORED SUNSCREEN LOTION
- *SANDALS , CROCS OR FLIP-FLOPS ARE ACCEPTABLE

DROP-OFF/PICK UP:

*PLEASE PARK IN FRONT OF BLOOMFIELD HALL AND WALK YOUR CAMPER INSIDE. PLEASE CHECK IN WITH A COUNSELOR UPON ARRIVAL.
*AT THE END OF THE DAY, PLEASE PARK AND COME INSIDE AND LOCATE YOUR CAMPER IN THE BUILDING OR ON THE PLAYGROUND. PLEASE CHECK IN WITH A COUNSELOR UPON DEPARTURE.

ILLNESS POLICY:

*PLEASE KEEP YOUR CAMPER AT HOME IF HE/SHE SHOWS ANY SIGNS OF ILLNESS.

COOPERATION POLICY:

*COOL CAMP IS A PLACE TO HAVE FUN, MAKE NEW FRIENDS, EXPLORE AND FEEL SAFE. SHOULD ANY OF THE CAMPERS HAVE DIFFICULTY COOPERATING AND FOLLOWING THE RULES MADE BY THE SCHOOL/COUNSELORS AND SUCH BEHAVIOR BECOMES DETRIMENTAL TO THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF OTHERS, LCPC MAY REQUIRE DISENROLLMENT.
